18.15–19.45h	Contemporary Dance Level 2 13–18 years	This class is a progression class for Level 1 participants. It focuses on developing contemporary technique and choreography.

18.15–19.30h	Dance Fusion 13–18 years	Open to all levels, this class fuses contemporary, jazz and street dance styles.
18.15–20.30h	Laban Youth Dance Company (LYDC) 15–18 years	For more experienced contemporary dancers, LYDC focuses on developing contemporary technique and performance skills, creative and choreographic work. Accessed via annual audition, LYDC performs throughout the year.

16.30–17.45h	Ignition 8–11 years (boys only)	A creative dance class for boys which fuses contemporary and other dance styles and choreography.
18.00–19.15h	Accelerate 11–14 years (boys only)	A creative dance class for boys which fuses contemporary and other dance styles and choreography.
19.15–20.30h	Velocity 13–18 years (boys only)	A class for boys which fuses hip-hop and street dance with contemporary choreographic techniques. Open to all levels.
18.30–20.00h	Youth Ballet 13–18 years	Open to all levels, this ballet class includes creative elements as well as classical technique.

FEES AND ENROLMENT

Priority is given to young people who live or attend school in the London Borough of Lewisham. Should the class/classes that you wish to attend be full you can register with a class waiting list.

The courses cost **£2** per class. The fee may be paid on a weekly, half-termly or termly basis.
